

## **Leak Diverter Instructions**



## You may need:

- 1. **Mounting Hardware** Hardware used to mount the leak diverter is not included. The mounting surface and building construction will determine the hardware used for installation. This may include zip ties, nylon rope (or other types of non-stretch rope), or wire. For these instructions, we will refer to them as rope.
- 2. Drain Hose Drain hoses are available for purchase separately by ENPAC. Sizes are 10' (SKU: 46-HOSE-10) and 25' (SKU: 46-HOSE-25). Garden hoses (0.75 in. GHT hose fitting) could also be used with this item.

## Installation:

Note: Any hose (sold separately) could be attached prior to installation if easier.

- 1. This item is available in a variety of sizes and comes with gommets at each corner. Larger sizes will have grommets along the edges at various intervals to safely secure the leak diverter.
- 2. The leak diverter is intended to be suspended directly beneath the source of a leak.
- 3. Thread the grommets with ropes and secure appropriately to the building.
- 4. The leak diverter should be as close to horizontal as possible to avoid ponding in the fabric. Ponding will prevent drainage and this item is not designed to hold water.
- 5. Attach a hose to drain any leaks. If the leak is intermittent, the drain cap may be used and the hose stored during dry conditions.
